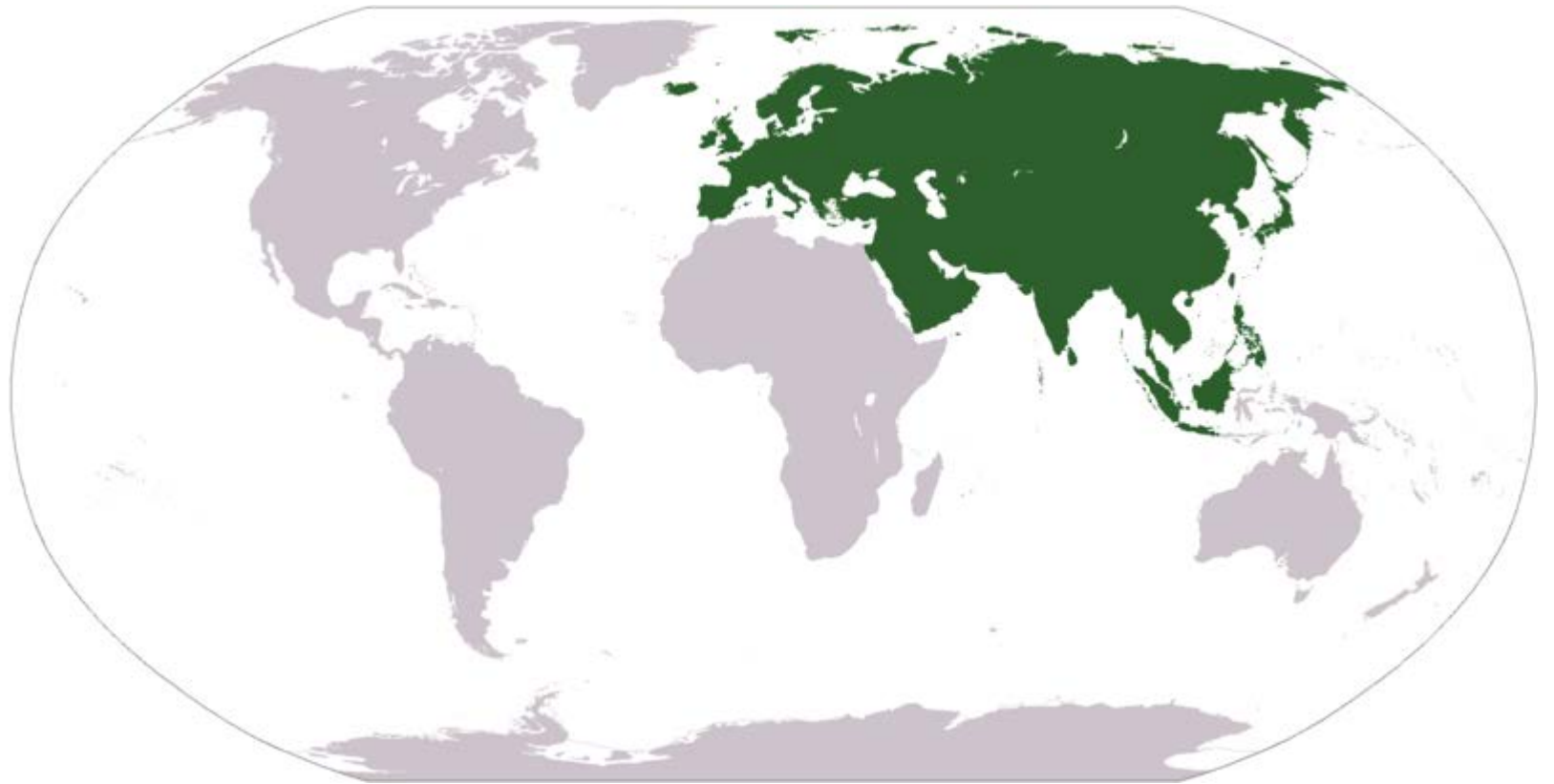

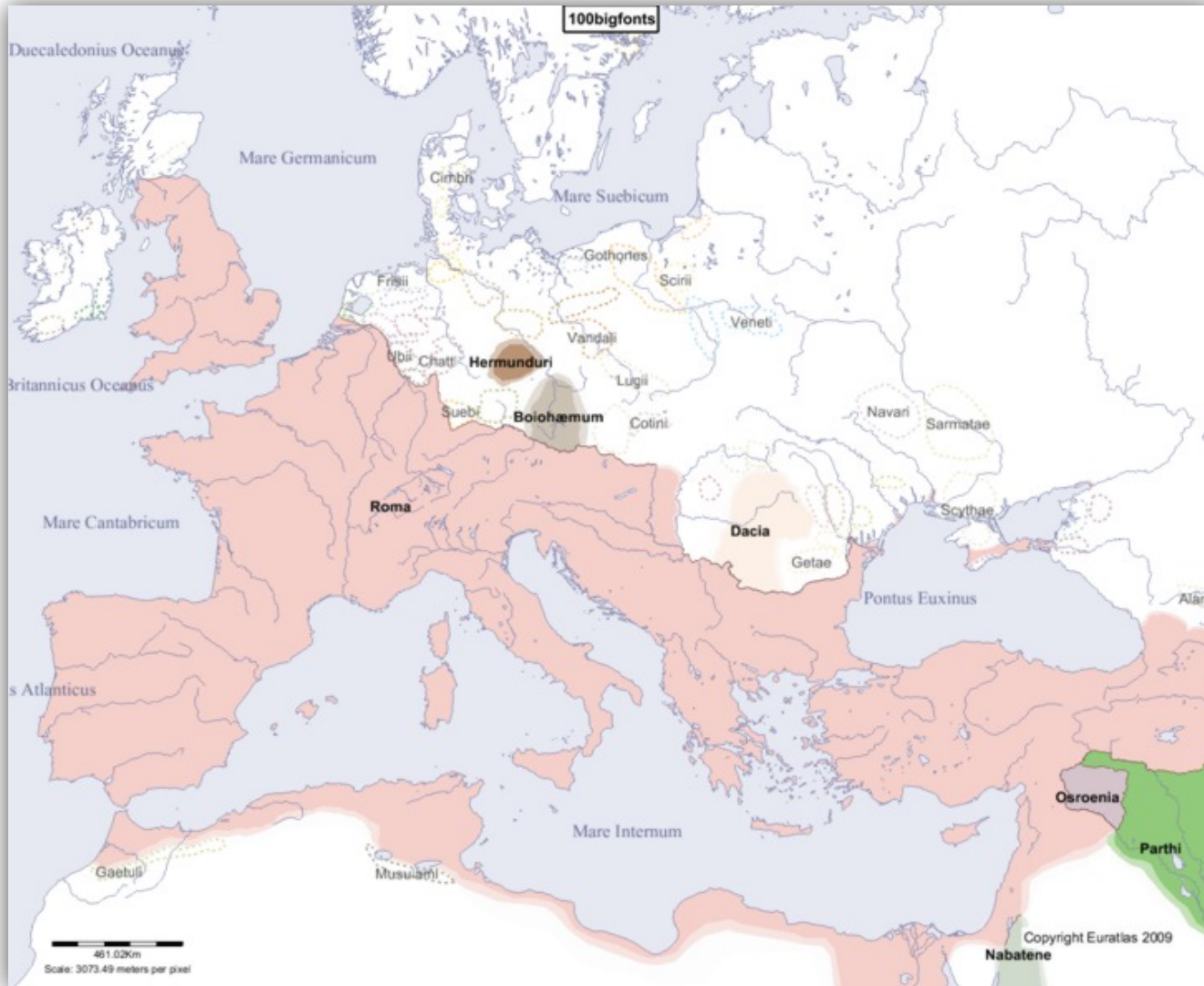

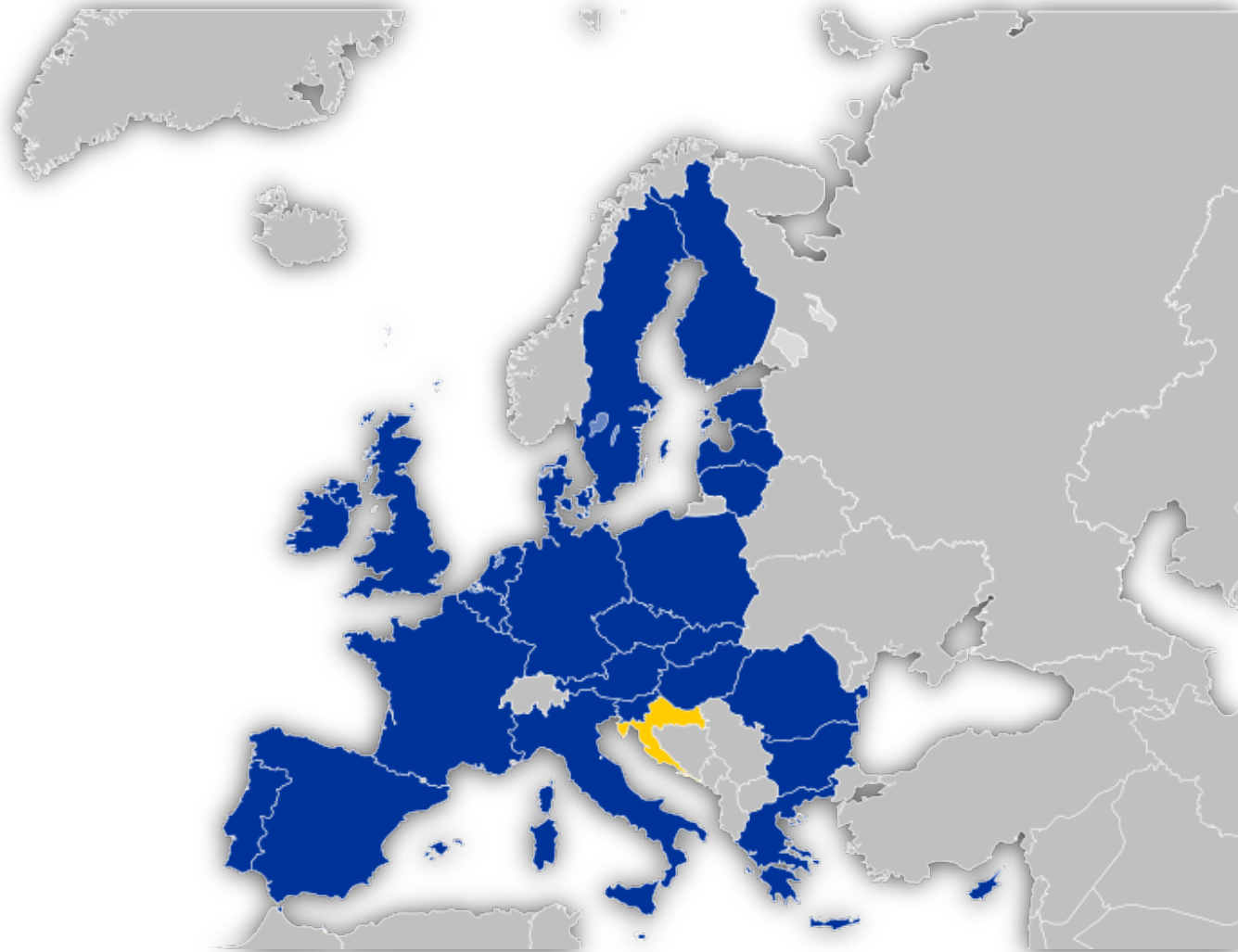




Europe is **not homogenous** with each other

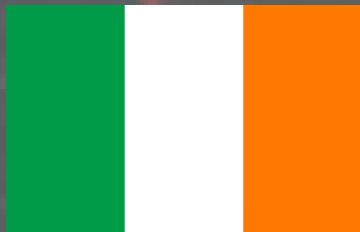

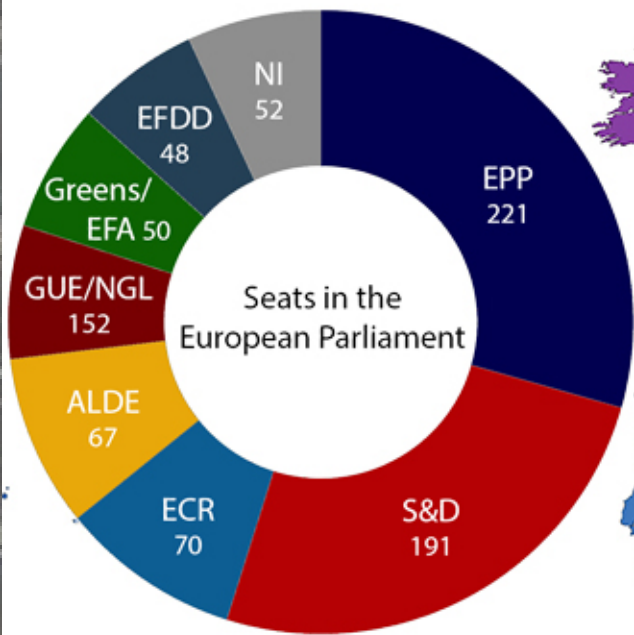
